Using jobdate.sty one can easily extract information from the filename, if it follows a certain form. The LaTeX command \jobname returns the name of the LaTeX file. If we have the filename follow a certain structure we can easily extract certain tokens that can be used inside the document. In the current form the package expects the filename to be of the form no-id-YYYY-MM-DD and offers the following commands:

• \getidfromjobname: Ziegenhagen

• \getnumberfromjobname: 01

• \getdayfromjobname: 31

• \getmonthfromjobname: 12

• \getyearfromjobname: 2007

• \getdatefromjobname: 31.12.2007
