Using `jobdate.sty` one can easily extract information from the filename, if it follows a certain form. The LaTeX command `\jobname` returns the name of the LaTeX file. If we have the filename follow a certain structure we can easily extract certain tokens that can be used inside the document. In the current form the package expects the filename to be of the form `no-id-YYYY-MM-DD` and offers the following commands:

- `\getidfromjobname`: Ziegenhagen
- `\getnumberfromjobname`: 01
- `\getdayfromjobname`: 31
- `\getmonthfromjobname`: 12
- `\getyearfromjobname`: 2007
- `\getdatefromjobname`: 31.12.2007
